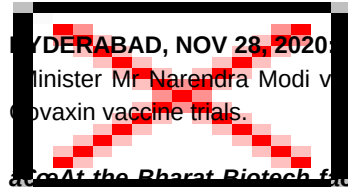


Modi congratulates Bharat Biotech for progress in Covaxin trials
