

Double taxation - CBDT lays down procedure to deal with taxpayers' pain

The matter has since been examined by CBDT.

In this context, Circular No. 2 of 2021

has been issued by CBDT yesterday. Vide the said Circular, it has been provided that if any individual is facing double taxation even after taking into account the relief provided by the relevant Double Taxation Avoidance Agreement (DTAA), he/she may furnish the specified information by 31st March, 2021 in Form â€"NR annexed to the said Circular.
