Lr. Kerry conveyed greetings President Biden to the Prime Minister. The Prime Minister fondly recalled his recent interactions with esident Biden including during the Quad Leaders' Summit and requested Mr. Kerry to convey his best wishes to President Biden and Vice President Kamala Harris.

Mr. Kerry briefed the Prime Minister on his fruitful and productive discussions over the last two days in India.
