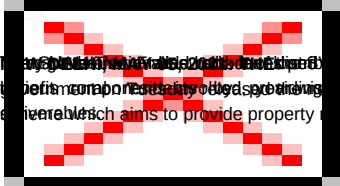


New framework for nationwide roll out of SVAMITVA scheme
